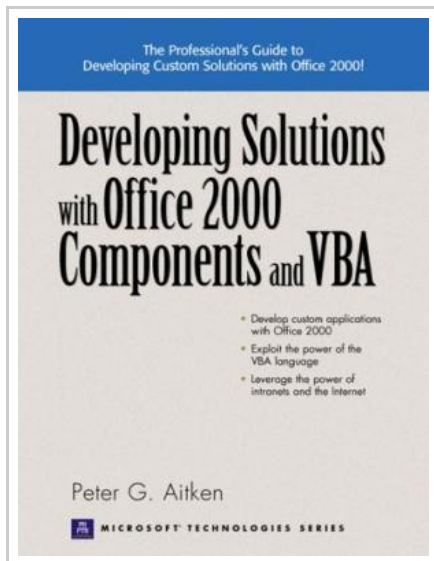




Developing Windows Solutions with Office 2000 Components and VBA (Paperback)
