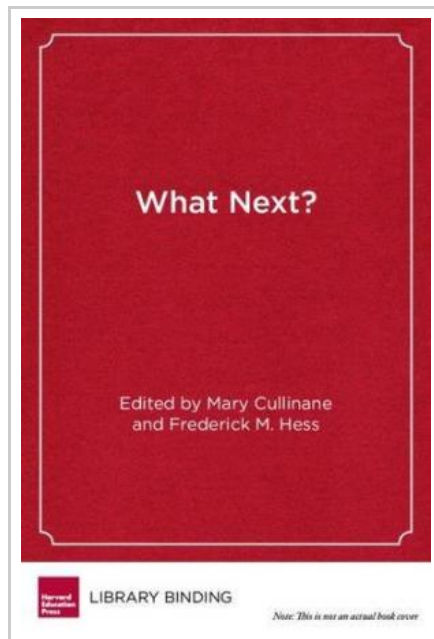




What Next?: Educational Innovation and Philadelphia's School of the Future
