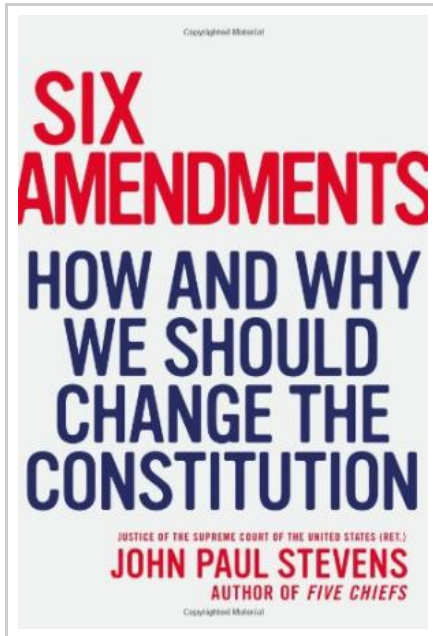




Six Amendments: How and Why We Should Change the Constitution
